FROM THE POLICE BLOTTER...

Shaunavon RCMP are asking the public's assistance with the following Crimes:

- Sometime during the evening of May 17, 2012 a "Road Closed" barricade was struck by an unknown vehicle completely destroying the sign. The offending vehicle fled but may have sustained damage to an oil reservoir beneath the vehicle.
- Sometime between 3AM and 10AM on May 19, 2012, the stop sign located at the intersection of Centre Street and Third Ave was run over by an unknown vehicle which fled the scene.
- In the evening of May 19 Frontier Fire Department and Shaunavon RCMP attended a structure fire in Frontier. The structure was unoccupied and was completely destroyed. The fire is of suspicious origin and is still under investigation.

On Wednesday May 23, 2012 Legacy Computers called to report that a HP Pavillion Laptop was shoplifted from their store. Shaunavon RCMP arrested Tanya Smith age 27 and Joey McConnell age 31 both of Medicine Hat. They were arrested and charged with Theft under \$5000 and Failure to Comply. Both appeared in Provincial Court on Friday, May 25, 2012. Smith and McConnell pled guilty.

On Wednesday May 23, 2012 Shaunavon RCMP and Frontier Fire Department were called to a car fire, 2 kilometers north of Climax. Vehicle file was not suspicious and there were no injuries in results of the fire.

On Saturday May 26, 2012 Shaunavon RCMP was dispatched to complaint of a natural gas line leak on Highway #18. Sask Energy advised. No injuries occurred.

On Sunday May 27, 2012 Shaunavon RCMP and Shaunavon Fire Department were dispatched to a fire on 5th Avenue East in Shaunavon. Due to heavy snow, trees broke and dislodged power lines causing lines to break causing a fire and disrupting power. No injuries, Sask Power repaired and restored power.

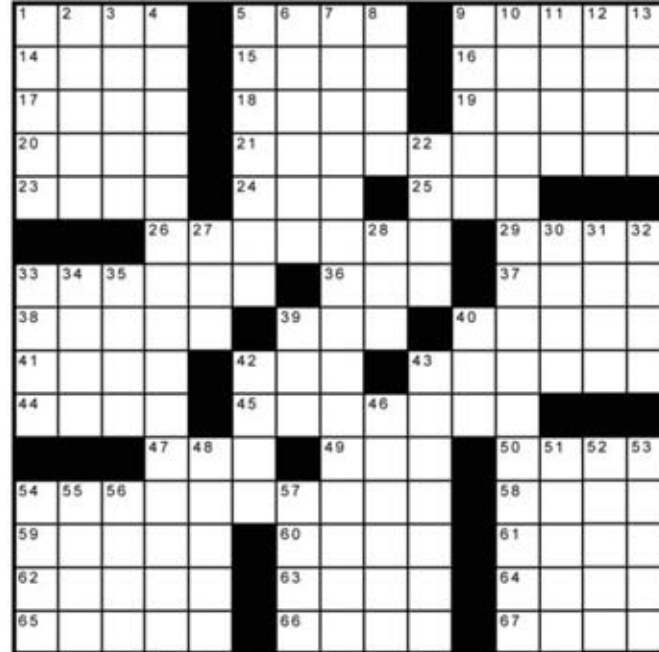
