Cal is perhaps the foremost expert on the history rail in Saskatchewan, having co-founded the Saskatchewan Railway Museum. Anyone with an interest in trains or history in general would be advised to arrive early.

A small selection of these photos will be on display at the Library. Adrian's passion for history led to the publication the book "An Honest, Genial and Kindly People." The book is filled with photographs of First Nations people from the turn of the century in southern Saskatchewan. Adrian Paton received a posthumous Saskatchewan Heritage Award for his book. Connie Big Eagle, chief of the Ocean Man First Nation, wrote the introduction to the book. Hugh Henry, director of the Saskatchewan History & Folklore Society, will open the exhibit and present a talk on Sunday, February 12 at 2:00 pm.
