Town Of Eastend By-Laws

TOWN OF EASTEND
BYLAW No. 557/99

A BYLAW RESPECTING FIRE PREVENTION IN THE TOWN OF EASTEND

Open Air Fires

No open open-air fires unless the following measures are taken:

- a) Fires must be contained in a non-combustible receptacle of cement, brick or sheet metal with a minimum 18-gauge thickness;
- b) A receptacle must be covered with a heavy metal screen with openings not exceeding 13 millimeters;

-All outdoor fires shall always have responsible supervision.

-The fuel for open-air fires may only consist of charcoal or cut, season wood. The burning of the following materials is **prohibited**: rubbish, garden refuse, manure, livestock or animal carcasses and any material classified as a dangerous good.

-Open-air fires must not be set in windy conditions.

-If smoke from an open-air fire causes an unreasonable interference with the use and enjoyment of another person's property, the fire must be extinguished immediately.

- The property owner/occupants are responsible for any or all damage as a result of burning.

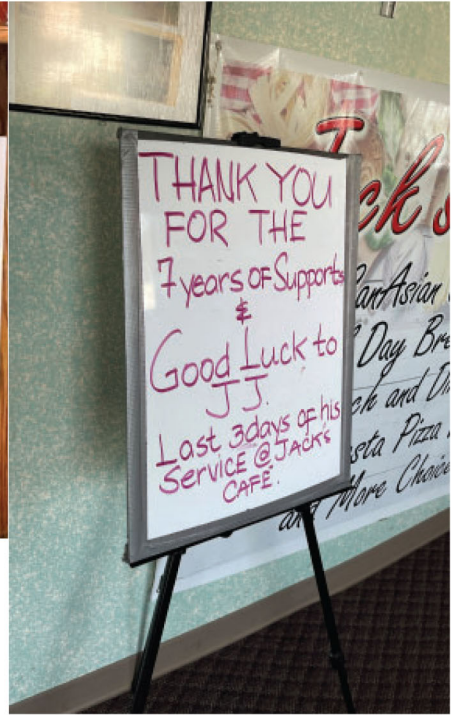

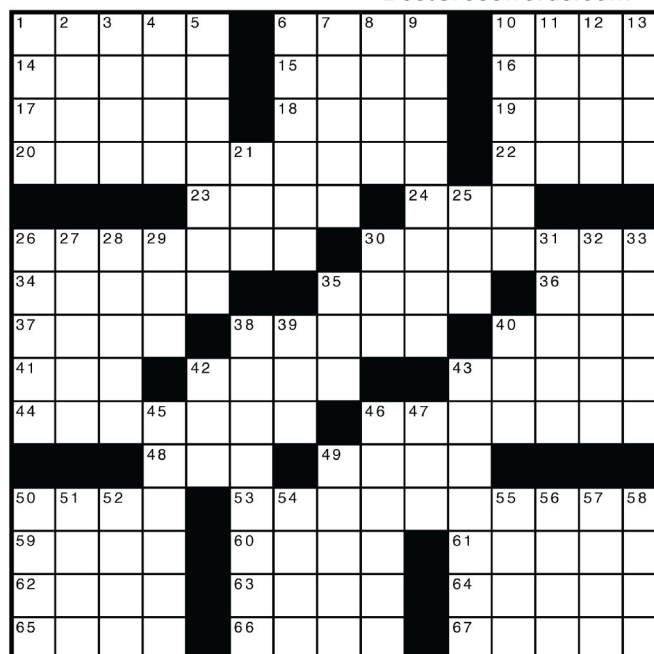
