MEMORIAL HALL FLOORS

The Memorial Hall has hired a professional to re-finish the floors in the Memorial Hall. The plan is to get this refinishing done before the Harvest Festival and Fowl Supper. Once the floors are re-finished, we are planning to have the business coming back for the next few years to add layers of protection on our dance floor. This should preserve what we have now for at least 40 years.

This re-finishing is going to take down 100% of the Hall's coffers at \$15,000 for the re-finishing.

The Hall Board is asking any one who wishes to help offset the cost to make donations toward the Hall floor at Eastend Agencies or the Town of Eastend office. Tax receipts will be given out for donations.

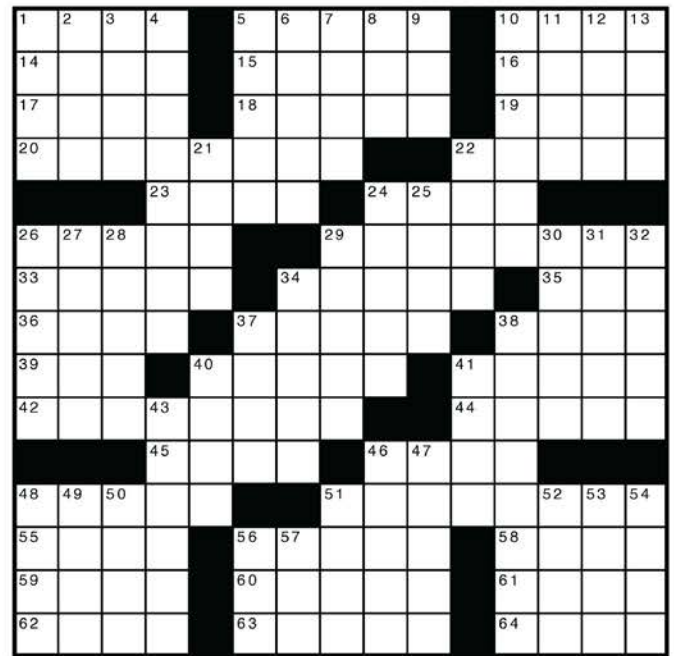

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
