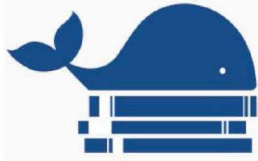

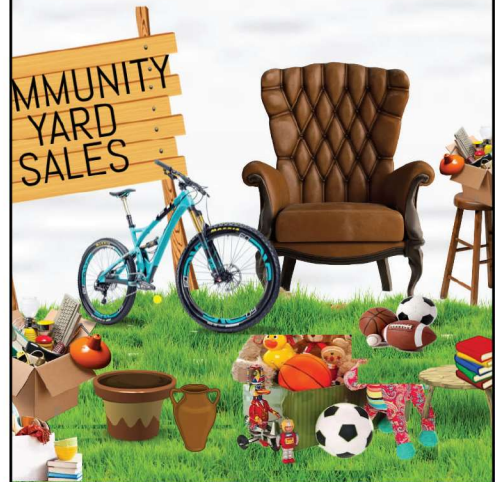

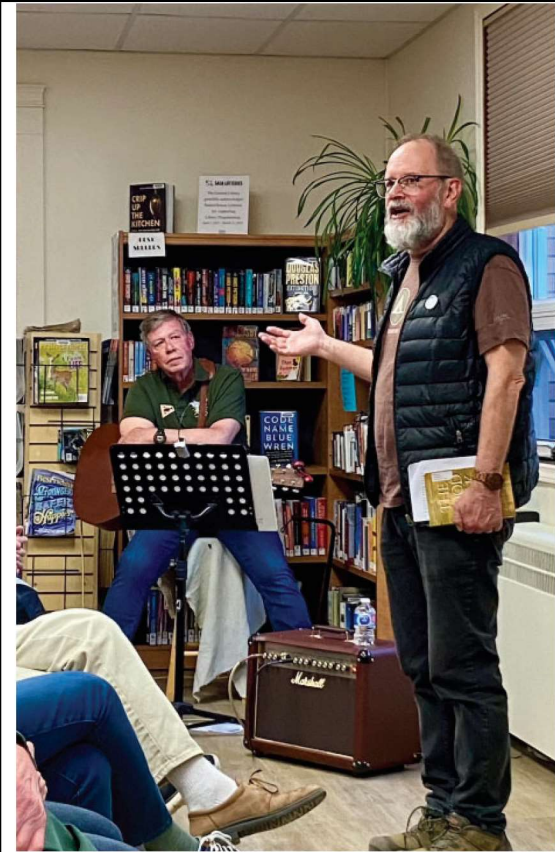


TREX DISCOVERY CENTRE *Open For the Season*



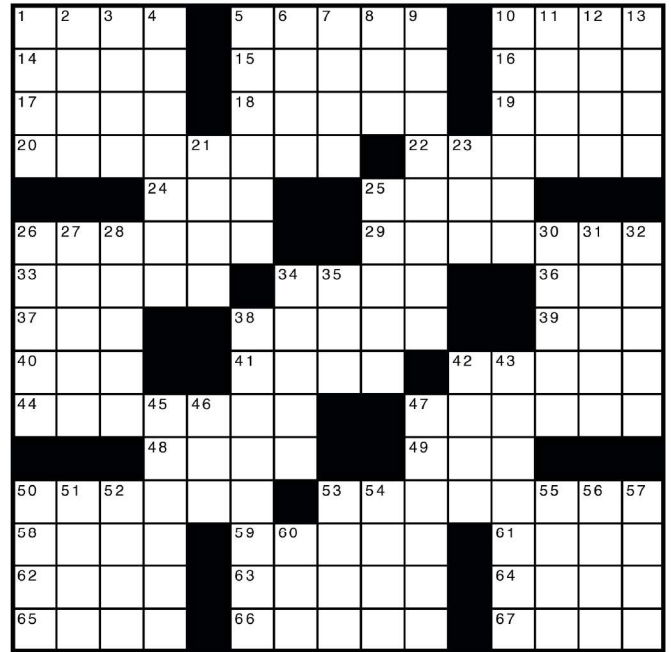


